The Roofing Works Project Manager oversees and manages roofing projects from initiation to completion. They are responsible for coordinating all aspects of the project, including planning, budgeting, scheduling, procurement, and quality control.

The Roofing Works Project Manager collaborates with internal teams, subcontractors, suppliers, and clients to ensure successful project execution and client satisfaction.

Responsibilities:

- You will manage the trade operatives across multiple sites and ensure all areas are running to deadlines
- You will be an experienced supervisor from either the roofing or housing sectors
- You will delegate work to the labourers on site and oversee their work
- Inspects work in progress and, when completed, to determine conformance to specifications
- Ensure time sheets of the site team are filled out correctly and honestly
- Look after the company vehicles, carrying out checks to ensure the vehicle's smooth running
- Demonstrate to new workers techniques of applying various types of roofing materials
- Liaising and constantly communicating with management and sub-contractors
- Planning labour requirements
- Providing regular coaching, training, evaluation and feedback
- Influence the crew to work safely and be disciplined and efficient
- Complete and maintain proper daily paperwork (i.e. time sheets, delivery invoices, safety checklist, toolbox talks, etc.)
- Examine roof and penetrations to plan jobs and strategically assign and allocate work to crew members, considering their desires, skills and temperaments
- Communicate and manage job-specific safety plans before the start of every job, conducting job-site audits and making alterations as conditions change
- Be an active participant or leader of weekly safety meetings
- Perform installation duties as necessary
- Plan daily work goals to complete jobs on time, striking an appropriate balance between speed and quality
- Manage workflow of crew and subcontractors
- Ensure quality and installation according to specifications and plan
- Keep projects on time and within budget
- Solve problems on-site, notifying the works manager if a specified installation is impossible
